Comtech Telecommunications Corp. Receives \$4.6 Million of Blue Force Tracking Orders for Its Mobile Data Communications Transceivers

The orders are for the supply of mobile transceiver terminals for Force XXI Battle Command Brigade and Below - Blue Force Tracking (FBCB2-BFT), a battle command real-time situational awareness and control system. Although the awards relate to the FBCB2-BFT Program, they were ordered against the Company's U.S. Army Movement Tracking System (MTS) Contract. Total orders received to date against the \$418.2 million MTS contract increased to \$200.1 million.

The continued deployment of our transceivers in the Blue Force Tracking System demonstrates the importance our technology plays in supporting this critical program."
