Comtech Telecommunications Corp. Receives \$4.0 Million of Blue Force Tracking Orders for its Mobile Data Communications Transceivers

The orders are for the supply of mobile terminal transceivers for Force XXI Battle Command Brigade and Below - Blue Force Tracking (FBCB2-BFT), a battle command real-time situational awareness command and control system. Although the orders relate to the FBCB2-BFT program, they were ordered against the Company's U.S. Army Movement Tracking System (MTS) contract, bringing the total orders received to-date against the \$418.2 million contract to \$158.9 million.
