Comtech Telecommunications Corp. Awarded \$3.3 Million Equipment Order to Support an Asian Mobile Network Operator's 2G+4G Backhaul Network Expansion

(NASDAQ:CMTL) announced today that during its first quarter of fiscal 2017, its Tempe, Arizona-based subsidiary, Comtech EF Data Corp., which is part of Comtech's Commercial Solutions segment, received a \$3.3 million equipment order to provide backhaul network expansion for one of the largest Mobile Network Operators (MNOs) in Asia.

This initial order represents approximately one third of the total planned network expansion project by the MNO.
